GRAYROCK ROARD AREA IN NEED OF REDEVELOPMENT STUDY

As part of the investigative process of the Planning Board, as set forth in the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq.), the Board must make a recommendation to the Township Council as to whether the above referenced properties qualify as an area in need of redevelopment. At the conclusion of the public hearing the Planning Board may provide the Clinton Township Council with its recommendations concerning the investigated properties and whether or not the properties and associated improvements qualify as an area in need of redevelopment.

Tom Behrens Jr., Board Planning Expert provided an overview of the process regarding an Area in Need of Redevelopment. Mr. Behrens then provided a summary of the proposed Grayrock Road Area in Need of Development Study. Mr. Behrens then communicated that the analysis contained in the study meets at least three (3) of the nine (9) Local Redevelopment and Housing Law statutory criteria to be designated as an area in need of redevelopment.

The following individual was sworn and testified during the hearing:

1. Robert Fernandes, 25 Mountainview Blvd., Basking Ridge, NJ.

Mr. Fernandes stated that he is the managing partner of Grayrock Village which has recently purchased Block 77.01, Lots 2 and 4. Mr. Fernandes identified this area for redevelopment and he has prepared plans for the site.

There was no one else from the public with questions or comments regarding the Grayrock Road Area in Need of Redevelopment Study.

Mr. Lazarus motioned and Ms. Butcher seconded a motion to recommend and adopt the memorializing resolution that property designated on the Township tax map as Block 77.01, Lots 2, 3 and 4, be designated as a Non-Condemnation Area in Need of Redevelopment. The vote record follows.
