**APPROVING THE EXTENSION REQUEST OF THE GRANT CONTRACT WITH  
THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE  
GRAYROCK ROAD, FAIRVIEW AVENUE, FULPER PLACE & FULPER ALLEY  
(NJDOT FY 2019) IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Clinton is the recipient of funding from the NJDOT for the Municipal Aid Program for the Grayrock Road, Fairview Avenue, Fulper Place & Fulper Alley (NJDOT FY 2019) Improvement Project in the amount of \$175,000; and

**WHEREAS**, that the Contract Documents preparation for bid advertisement was impacted due to the COVID-19 pandemic and working remotely for compliance with social distancing requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the anticipated project commencement was delayed due to utility connections along Grayrock road for a private development at Block 74 Lots 16, 18, and 19 (aka Zinn Realty, LLC) which experienced a work shutdown; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Township of Clinton has two (2) years from the date of the NJDOT award notification letter, dated March 25, 2021, to award the project.

**THEREFORE**, on behalf of Mayor and Council, the Township of Clinton is requesting a six (6) month time extension for the above referenced project.

## RESOLUTION

### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IMPLEMENTATION OF MANDATORY PAYROLL DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR ALL TOWNSHIP EMPLOYEES AND ELECTED OFFICIALS

**WHEREAS**, P.L. 2013 c.28 (codified at N.J.S.A. 51:14-15f) authorizes municipalities to provide for the mandatory direct deposit of net pay for all employees and elected officials effective on or after June 1, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Clinton (the "Township") has reviewed its payroll processing methods to better align and streamline functionality and increase productivity with business operations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township is committed to providing employee benefits designed to provide safety and reliability; and

**WHEREAS**, payroll direct deposit provides timeliness, safety, and reliability of employees' pay; and

**WHEREAS**, this policy will require employees and elected officials of the Township to indicate in writing, to the Chief Financial Officer, the specific banking institution(s) and designated checking account(s), and/or savings account(s) to which the deposit shall be made on behalf of the employee or elected official; and

**WHEREAS**, any employee or elected official seeking an exemption from this policy may apply in writing to the Chief Financial Officer of the Township, who shall forward the requested exemption to the Administrator for approval, which it may grant or deny in its absolute discretion.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Council of the Township of Clinton that, effective June 1, 2021 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14-15f, mandatory direct deposit of net pay for all employees and elected officials of the Township of Clinton shall be made to the specific banking institution(s) provided by each employee or elected official.
