### **AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TURNOUT GEAR AND A THERMAL IMAGE CAMERA FROM FIREFIGHTER ONE THROUGH STATE CONTRACT #17-FLEET-00811 & #17-FLEET-00819, NTE \$35,000**

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to purchase turnout gear and a thermal image camera for Annandale Hose Company #1 of the Township of Clinton; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds are available as evidenced by the Chief Finance Officer's Certification through Capital Ordinance #1143-2020 for \$35,000; and

**WHEREAS**, public bids are not required when the purchase is made through a State contract in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton in the County of Hunterdon that the Annandale Hose Company #1 of the Township of Clinton is hereby authorized to purchase turnout gear and a thermal image camera through State contract #17-FLEET-00811 & #17-FLEET-00819 through Capital Ordinance #1143-2020 for \$34,986.50 for a NTE of \$35,000.

## RESOLUTION

### AWARDING GOODS AND SERVICES AGREEMENT

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Clinton desires to retain the services of a qualified firm for purposes of providing IT support services for the Public Safety Building and Municipal offices on an as-needed basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has solicited and received informal quotes for the provision of these services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has a need to acquire these services without a “fair and open process” as defined by P.L. 2004, c.19, the “Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law” and in connection therewith, River Net Computers, LLC has completed and filed with the Township the required Campaign Contributions Affidavit pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.8 and Certification Regarding Political Contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.26 (collectively, the “Pay-to-Play Forms”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Township seeks to award the contract to River Net Computers, LLC based on the contract on file in the Clerk’s office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement shall be for an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 and for an initial term of one year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available to pay for said services from River Net Computers, LLC; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3a, authorizes the Township to award this agreement without public bidding because it will not exceed the bid threshold.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with River Net Computers, LLC, consistent with this Resolution and the above “Whereas” clauses.
2. The agreement is awarded without competitive bidding as authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3a.
3. The firm of River Net Computers, LLC shall be paid a fee not to exceed \$10,000.00, based on the fees set forth above and in the Agreement.
4. The initial term of the agreement shall be one year, and the term may be extended for up to two additional one-year terms, subject to the prior consent of the parties, compliance with the New Jersey Local Public

Contracts Law, and the Township's availability of sufficient funds for subsequent years.

5. A copy of this Resolution and the Agreement shall be placed on file in the Office of the Clerk.
