RESOLUTION REVISING APPROVED 2020 CARRY-OVER VACATION DAYS AND AMENDING RESOLUTION #22-2021

WHEREAS, section “Vacation (f)” of the Clinton Township Personnel Policies, Practices and Regulations permits employees to carry over unused 2020 vacation days into 2021; and,

WHEREAS, permission to do so must be granted by Mayor and Council; and,

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2021, the Mayor and Council adopted Resolution #22-2021, which set forth the number of unused 2020 vacation hours various employees would be allowed to carry over into 2021; and

WHEREAS, for certain of those employees, the number of hours listed in Resolution #22-2021 inadvertently included carry-over hours from 2019 as well as 2020; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to correct this oversight by adjusting the number of approved carry-over hours for the affected employees as set forth below;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, as follows:

RESOLUTION

AWARDING SERVICE AGREEMENT TO CEDAR RIDGE EXCAVATING & LANDSCAPING FOR BRUSH HOGGING SERVICES ON PARK TRAILS IN 2021

WHEREAS, the Township of Clinton desires to obtain the services of a landscaping company for brush hogging of trails on Hackett’s Preserve, Prostak Preserve and Windy Acres Preserve during 2021; and

WHEREAS, following the solicitation of informal quotes, Cedar Ridge Landscaping & Excavating submitted a written proposal to the Township for purposes of performing this service for the 2021 season as follows:

Hackett’s Preserve	\$220.00 per cutting
Prostak Preserve	\$180.00 per cutting
Windy Acres Preserve	\$285.00 per cutting

WHEREAS, the Township has a need to acquire these services without a “fair and open process” as defined by P.L. 2004, c.19, the “Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law” and in connection therewith, Cedar Ridge Landscaping & Excavating has completed and filed with the Township the required Campaign Contributions Affidavit pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.8 and Certification Regarding Political Contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.26 (collectively, the “Pay-to-Play Forms”); and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Director’s estimate of \$7,000 for this service, in addition to the contract awarded to Cedar Ridge authorized by Resolution #48-2021 for mowing services, does not exceed the applicable bid threshold and therefore this contract may be awarded without public bidding under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts law; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available from line item #14-260-05-000-007 for this purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton as follows:

1. The Recreation Director is authorized to accept the proposal provided by Cedar Ridge Landscaping & Excavating for trail brush hogging services at Hackett’s Preserve Prostak Preserve and Windy Acres for a not to exceed amount of \$7,000.
2. A copy of this Resolution, executed Agreement and Pay-to-Play Forms shall be placed on file in the office of the Township Clerk.

WHEREAS, Clinton Township has the need on a timely basis to purchase goods and services utilizing the OMNIA Partners Government Purchasing Alliance National Coop; and

WHEREAS, Clinton Township may enter into contracts with the referenced OMNIA Partners Government Purchasing Alliance National Coop vendors through this resolution and properly executed contracts, which shall be subject to all the conditions applicable to the current OMNIA Partners Government Purchasing Alliance National Coop;

WHEREAS, the funds are available as evidenced by the Chief Finance Officer's Certification; and
