RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION #53-2021 AWARDING OF CONTRACT TO CMC ENERGY SERVICES AS THE BPU DIRECT INSTALL CONTRACTOR FOR ENERGY EFFICIENT MEASURES FOR VARIOUS TOWNSHIP FACILITIES, NTE \$13,373.10

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey Board of Public Utilities awarded a contract to CMC Energy Services, 1249 South River Road, Suite 103, Cranbury, NJ 08512 for the New Jersey Clean Energy Direct Install Program; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Clinton is participating in the NJ Clean Energy Direct Install Program for five facilities in the Township of which a summary of the costs, the projected savings, and the estimated payback period of the investment is included; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of improvements totals \$66,865.49 of which the Township's contributory portion totals \$13,373.10; and

WHEREAS, the BPU Energy Assessment calculations show an annual savings at \$16,612.31 with a payback period of approximately eight months on the Township funded portion; and

WHEREAS, it is the combined recommendation of the Construction Official and the Administrator to award this contract to CMC Energy Services; and

WHEREAS, the funds are available as evidenced by the Chief Finance Officer's Certification; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, that the contract be awarded to CMC Energy Services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of Township of Clinton that the Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to issue a purchase order to CMC Energy Services in the amount of \$13,373.10

WHEREAS, the Township of Clinton wishes to purchase Police Department Body Cameras from an authorized vendor under the State of New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Program; and
