## **RESOLUTION**

### **TO COMPLY WITH PROMULGATIONS OF THE LOCAL FINANCE BOARD FOR REVIEW OF THE ANNUAL (2021) AUDIT**

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-4 requires the governing body of every local unit to have made an annual audit of its books, accounts and financial transactions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Report of Audit for the year 2021 has been filed by a Registered Municipal Accountant with the Municipal Clerk as per the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:5-6, and a copy has been received by each member of the governing body; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Finance Board has promulgated a regulation requiring that the Governing Body of each municipality shall by resolution certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the governing body have reviewed, as a minimum, the sections of the annual audit entitled: General Comments, Recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the governing body have personally reviewed as a minimum the Annual Report of Audit, and specifically the sections of the Annual Audit entitled: General Comments, Recommendations as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the Governing Body; and,

**WHEREAS**, there were no recommendations for a corrective action plan; and

**WHEREAS**, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the Governing Body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, as per the regulations of the Local Finance Board; and

**WHEREAS**, all members of the Governing Body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

**WHEREAS**, failure to comply with the promulgations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of R.S. 52:27BB-52 – to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52 – “A local officer or member of a local governing body, who after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the Director of Local Government Services, under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.”

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton hereby states that it has complied with the promulgation of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey dated July 30, 1968 and does hereby submit a certified copy of this resolution and the required affidavit to said Board to show evidence of said compliance.

## RESOLUTION

### TO DEFER LOCAL DISTRICT AND REGIONAL SCHOOL TAXES

**WHEREAS**, the Local District School Tax for the Year July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023, was raised in the 2022 Tax Levy in the sum of \$27,826,274.00 and the Regional High School District Tax for the year July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023, was raised in the 2022 Tax Levy in the sum of \$13,808,261.00, and

**WHEREAS**, the statutes permit the deferral of such School Tax up to 50% of the School Tax Levy or \$13,913,137.00 for the Local District School Tax and \$6,904,130.50 for the Regional High School District Tax,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton, County of Hunterdon, that the Deferred School Tax for the Local District School Tax be the sum of \$12,841,419.50 which is 46.15% and that the Deferred School Tax for the Regional High School District School Tax be the sum of \$6,554,652.00 which is 47.47% as of December 31, 2022, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that three certified copies of this resolution be filed in the Office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
