ORDINANCE
1200 – 2024

CAPITAL ORDINANCE FOR VARIOUS ROADS IMPROVEMENTS BY THE
TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY,
APPROPRIATING THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$1,153,531.00 OF WHICH
\$1,000,000.00 IS FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL FUND, CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT FUND, AND \$153,531.00 IS FROM NEW JERSEY
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON,
IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The various improvements set forth in section 2 below are hereby authorized as general improvements to be made or acquired by the Township of Clinton in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey. For the said improvements or purposes stated in the said section 2, there is hereby appropriated the total sum of \$1,153,531.00; with \$1,000,000.00 from monies available in the General Capital Fund, Capital Improvement Fund of the Township and \$153,531.00 is from monies available in the General Capital Fund, Capital Fund Balance of the Township.

Section 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the purpose for which said appropriation is made are the roadway improvements to be made, by the Township of Clinton as more specifically set forth in the Township's 2024 capital budget.

Section 3. The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of the Local Government Services are on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.


Section 4. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated;

- (a) The purposes described in Section 2 of the capital ordinance are capital expenses and are each improvements the Township may lawfully make as a general improvement, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specifically assessed on property specially benefited thereby.
- (b) The average period of usefulness of said purposes within the limitations of the Local Bond Law and taking into consideration the respective amounts of the said authorized for the several purposes, according to the

reasonable life thereof computed by this capital ordinance, at least five (5) years.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after its final passage, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181.
