All dogs living in the Township for ten (10) days or more must be licensed annually during January. Puppies do not need to be licensed until six (6) months of age. Unlicensed dogs are subject to summons from the Animal Control Officer. Please notify us if your dog is deceased or no longer living in Clinton Township.

Rabies certificate must be valid through October 31 of the current year, per N.J.A.C 8:23A 4.1.

- If your dog cannot be vaccinated, a licensed veterinarian will need to complete a Rabies Exempt Form.
- If you are licensing for the **first time**, a copy of the rabies certification **MUST BE** submitted.
- If this is a **renewal**, and the rabies shot does not expire before October 31 of the current year you do not need to submit the certificate.
