

ORDINANCE NO. 1163-2022

**APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
FUND FOR TRUCK DIAGNOSTIC SCANNER FOR THE PUBLIC
WORKS DEPARTMENT BY THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON, IN
THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON,
IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township of Clinton, in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey (the "Township") for the purchase of the following heavy truck diagnostic scanning equipment for the Public Works Department and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto:

Heavy Truck Diagnostic Scanner, Connectors, and various parts

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law
